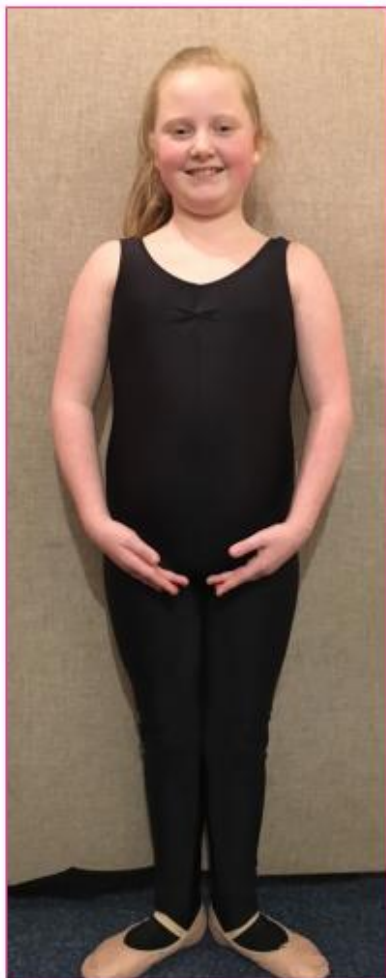




Uniform



Once your child is settled at SSDA, we ask our students to wear a uniform, which is also required for examinations. Please check with Miss Amy or Miss Laura but generally speaking for our younger students this is black lycra leggings with stirrups, a purple lycra leotard and a matching skirt for ballet and tap classes (a black unitard for boys). For older students, it is black lycra leggings with stirrups and a black lycra leotard (no skirt is required). These can be ordered from us and we can help with sizes.



For tap and ballet classes, students will need black tap shoes, with heel taps, and pink ballet shoes and socks (black for boys). Bare feet is fine for all other classes although students may wish to wear jazz shoes for Freestyle and Musical Theatre. We do have some second-hand shoes available to purchase. If you would like to have a look please ask one of the teachers.

We ask that students arrive on time for lessons and ensure that hair is tied up neatly. Jewellery should be removed before the lesson and students should not be eating or chewing gum whilst dancing.
